In this interactive workshop, you will score and discuss SCT cases with various scenarios.

### What is Script Concordance?

- The script concordance test (SCT) is an educational tool designed to assess and evaluate clinical reasoning. Similar to a case study, it simulates a clinical situation in which a physician must make decisions about diagnosis, treatment, or management.
- However, unlike a case study, there is no single “right answer.” Critical reasoning skills are promoted by allowing the participant to compare his or her decision with votes and rationales provided by a panel of experts.
- SCT thus enables participants to reflect on their own reasoning process and engage in dynamic discussions concerning the similarities and differences between their choices and those of the experts. The process and discussions re-enforce key learning points and stimulate clinical reasoning competence.

### At the conclusion of this program, participants will be better able to:

- Implement effective individualized OAB treatment
- Modify treatment when necessary
- Identify and address concerns regarding the treatment of
  - Male patients considering issues around LUTS, prostate symptoms
  - Elderly female patients with multiple comorbidities
